



Covid-19 Policy

In the event of a positive case of Covid-19 at Marsh Green Pre-school we will follow advice given to us by Public Health England and the Department for Education.

If a child or staff member shows symptoms of Covid-19, they will need to go home and organise a test. If the result is negative, they can return to pre-school. Should the result be positive, they will need to self-isolate and will not be able to attend pre-school until at least 5 days after their positive result and when they have had 2 negative lateral flow tests, 24 hours apart.

In the event of Marsh Green Pre-school having to close parents will be notified via email and on the Marsh Green Pre-school Closed Facebook group. Children who pay for a private place and are not government funded will be refunded their sessions (this will come off their next invoice for the following term).

Should a parent choose to take their child out of pre-school when the pre-school is open fees will still be applied.

Staff will use our closed Facebook group to send out home learning activities for any child that is having to self-isolate due to Covid-19.
